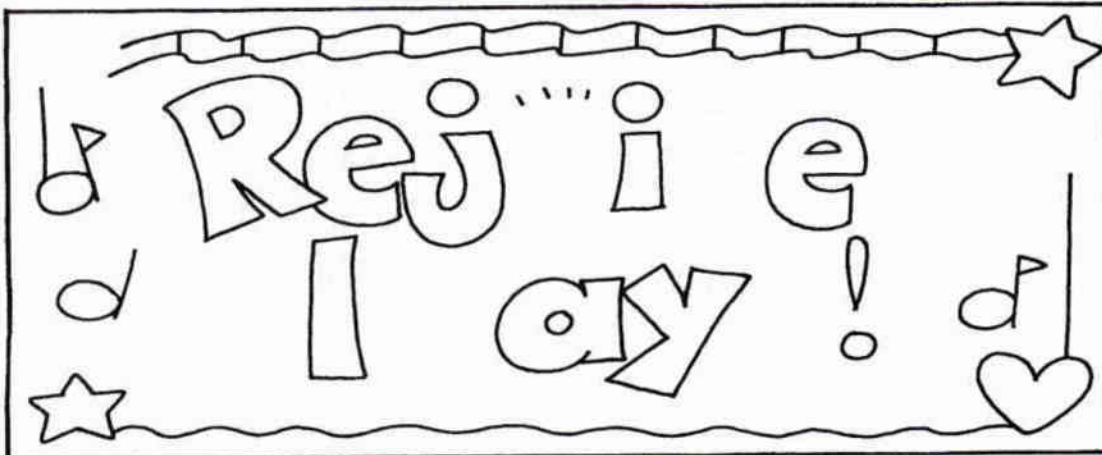
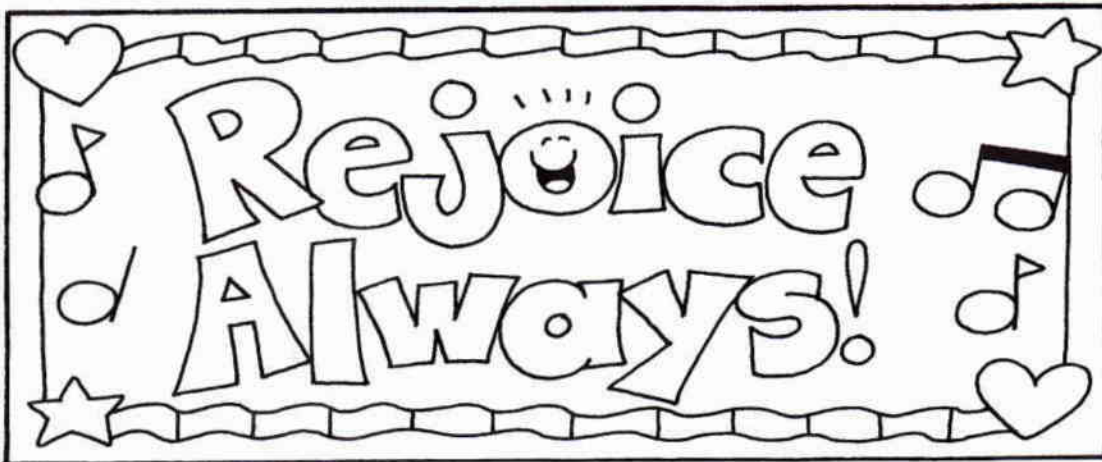

Third Sunday of Advent

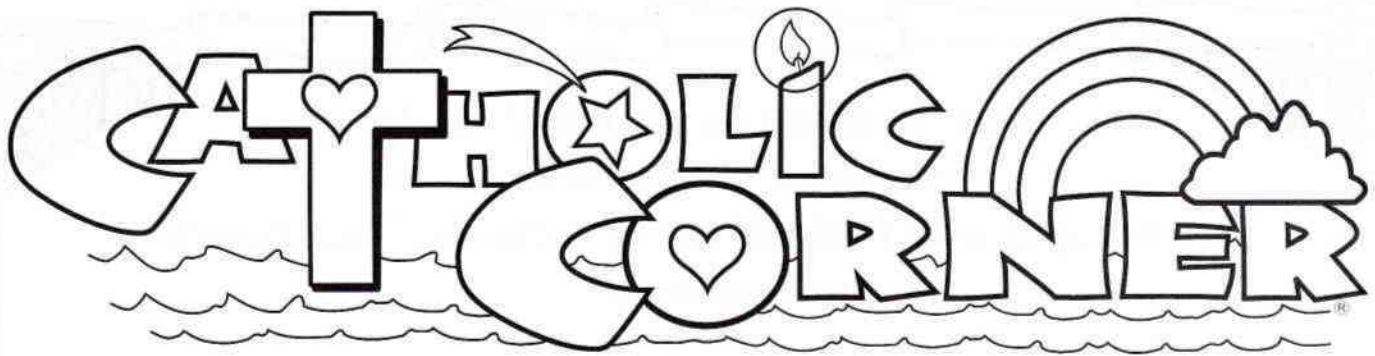
God is so wonderful and good!

Do you have any Christmas cards, old or new, with a picture of this place?

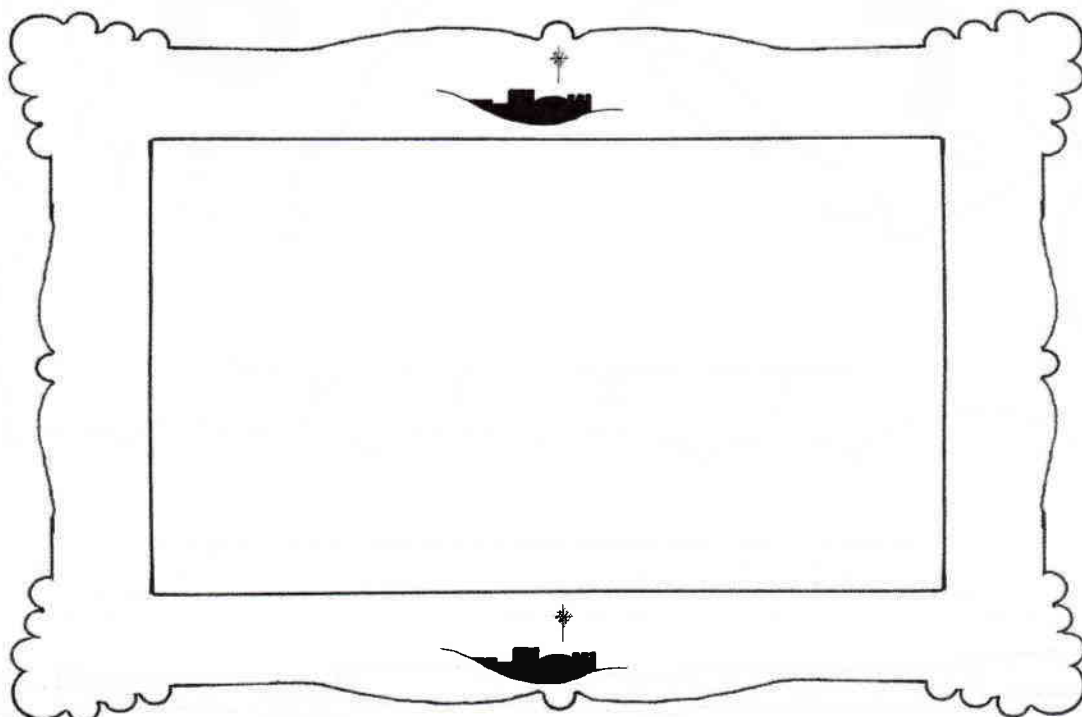
Glue the picture from the card in this space; or you can draw it yourself.
