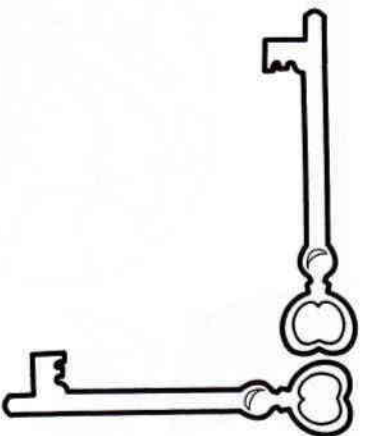
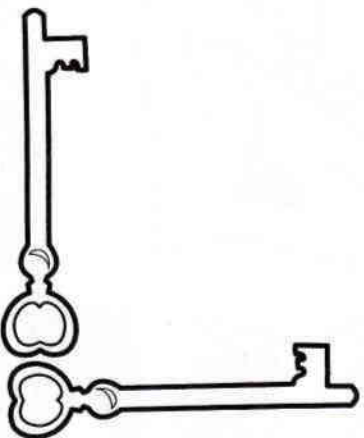
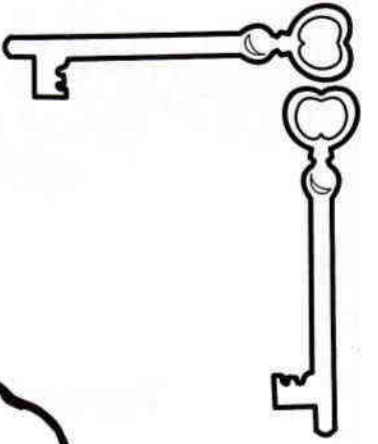
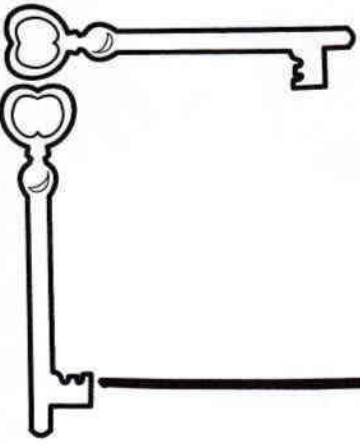
Help the children find their way to the temple to worship.

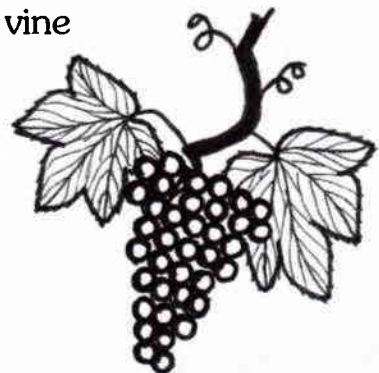

(John 10:11).





