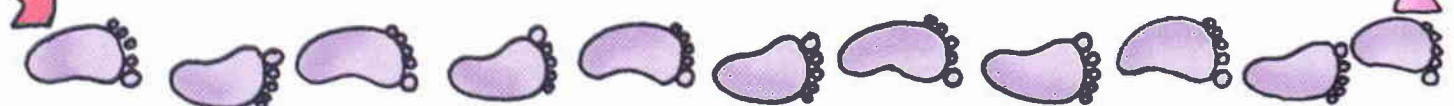

In today's Gospel we see Jesus calling his first disciples.

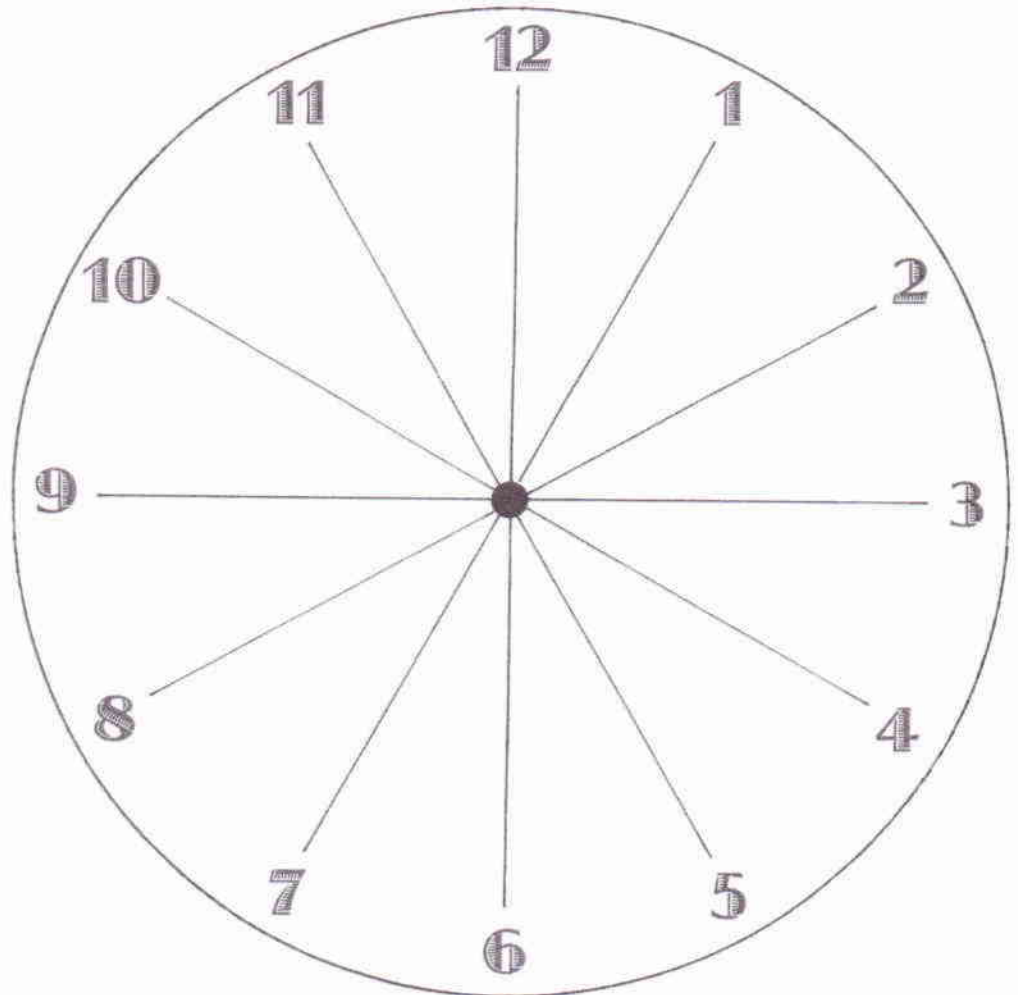
This was such an important event in their lives that scripture even records the time of day when it happened—
