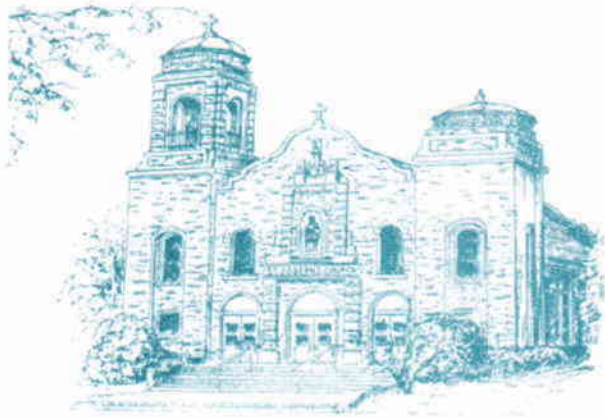

Desde el escritorio del Pastor

From the Pastor's Desk

Queridos amigos,

Dear Friends,

In the autumn of 1974, Mother Teresa of Calcutta visited Britain to thank the many people who were responding so generously to her work. This was the result of a BBC documentary about her Missionaries of Charity, entitled *Something Beautiful for God*. Now picture this diminutive nun in Durham Cathedral, her head just peeping over the huge pulpit, yet holding a packed congregation spellbound. She had chosen for her subject Matthew's last judgment passage and she kept returning to the question; "Do you really know who your neighbor is?" She was eminently practical, acknowledging that for the majority of the congregation, the possibility of being able to pack up and go to Calcutta and work with her there was a non-starter. But she was at pains to remind us that we did not need to go to Calcutta to find our poor brothers and sisters in need of our help.

There is a temptation to view the last judgment as some kind of final examination, which we either pass or fail and which we approach in trepidation, hoping that we will have done enough to sneak into heaven. Haunted by such an understanding, we may view the moral life as a kind of game, which we play with God or which God plays with us. But, for all the sufferings we endure and the sins we commit, God's judgment is not some kind of lottery. It is worth noting that St. John, whose gospel was written much later than the three synoptic gospels, recalls Jesus advising us that the judgment has already taken place.

This rather enriching view of the last judgment brings us neatly back to St. Teresa of Calcutta, for here we have a saint of our time, who lived out before our eyes this vision, recognizing that the sole criterion by which we will be judged is the recognition of Christ in our neighbor. So, can we answer her question: "Do you really know who your neighbor is?" In Durham Cathedral she warned everyone that it is all too easy to have great plans on God's behalf to reach out to a broken world, while at the same time being oblivious to the person in our own family who is crying out for help. How we judge ourselves here and now may help us to prepare well for the final accounting.

Last year we had our Year of Mercy, inspired by the desire of Pope Francis that we be a compassionate Church, looking out for one another and sharing in the ministry of shepherding one another into the kingdom. Indeed he encouraged the clergy to live "with the smell of the sheep", but there is no reason why we should not extend that invitation to everyone, for there is the rub. Once we have encountered the Lord and been baptized, we are already living the new life of the kingdom and sharing in his priestly ministry, and in that sense we are all called to be his shepherds.

En el otoño de 1974, la Madre Teresa de Calcuta visitó Gran Bretaña para agradecer a las muchas personas que estaban respondiendo generosamente a su trabajo. Este fue el resultado de un documental de la BBC sobre sus Misioneras de la Caridad, titulado algo hermoso por Dios. Ahora imagine que esta diminutiva monja en la catedral de Durham, su cabeza sólo expiando por el enorme púlpito, pero manteniendo una empaquetada congregación hechizadora. Ella había elegido para su tema la última sentencia del pasaje de Mateo y ella seguía regresando a la pregunta, "¿Usted realmente sabe quién es tu prójimo?" Ella era eminentemente práctica, reconociendo que para la mayoría de la congregación, la posibilidad de poder hacer las maletas e ir a Calcuta y trabajar con ella no hubo un motor de arranque. Pero ella se esforzó para recordarnos que nosotros no necesitamos ir a Calcuta para encontrar a nuestros hermanos y hermanas pobres que necesitan de nuestra ayuda.

Existe la tentación de ver la última sentencia como algún tipo de examen final, que nos pasan y que aplicamos en la emoción, con la esperanza de que habremos hecho lo suficiente para entrar en el cielo. Atormentado por esa comprensión, podemos ver la vida moral como una especie de juego, que jugamos con Dios o que Dios juega con nosotros. Pero, de todos los sufrimientos que hemos soportado y los pecados que cometemos, el juicio de Dios no es una especie de lotería. Vale la pena señalar que San Juan, cuyo evangelio fue escrito mucho más tarde que los tres evangelios sinópticos, recuerda que Jesús nos aconsejó que la sentencia ya ha tenido su lugar.

Esta experiencia y enriquecedora visión de la última sentencia ordenadamente nos trae de vuelta a Santa Teresa de Calcuta, tenemos aquí un santo de nuestro tiempo, que vivía ante nuestros ojos esta visión, reconociendo que el único criterio por el cual seremos juzgados, es el reconocimiento de Cristo en nuestro prójimo. Así, podemos responder a su pregunta: "usted realmente sabe quién es tu prójimo?" En la catedral de Durham advirtió a todos que todo es demasiado fácil tener grandes planes en nombre de Dios, para llegar a un mundo roto, mientras que al mismo tiempo se olvida a la persona en nuestra propia familia que clama por ayuda. Cómo debemos juzgarnos a nosotros mismos, aquí y ahora, nos ayude a prepararnos bien para la contabilidad final.

El año pasado tuvimos nuestro año de misericordia, inspirado por el deseo del Papa Francisco que seamos una iglesia compasiva, buscando otro y compartir en el ministerio de apacentar el uno al otro en el reino. De hecho animó a los sacerdotes a vivir "con el olor de las ovejas", pero no hay ninguna razón por la que no deberíamos extender esa invitación a todos, por ahí es donde aprieta el zapato. Una vez que hemos encontrado al Señor y han sido bautizados, ya estamos viviendo la vida nueva del reino y compartir en su ministerio sacerdotal y, en este sentido, todos estamos llamados a ser sus pastores.
