

"GOD WITH US"

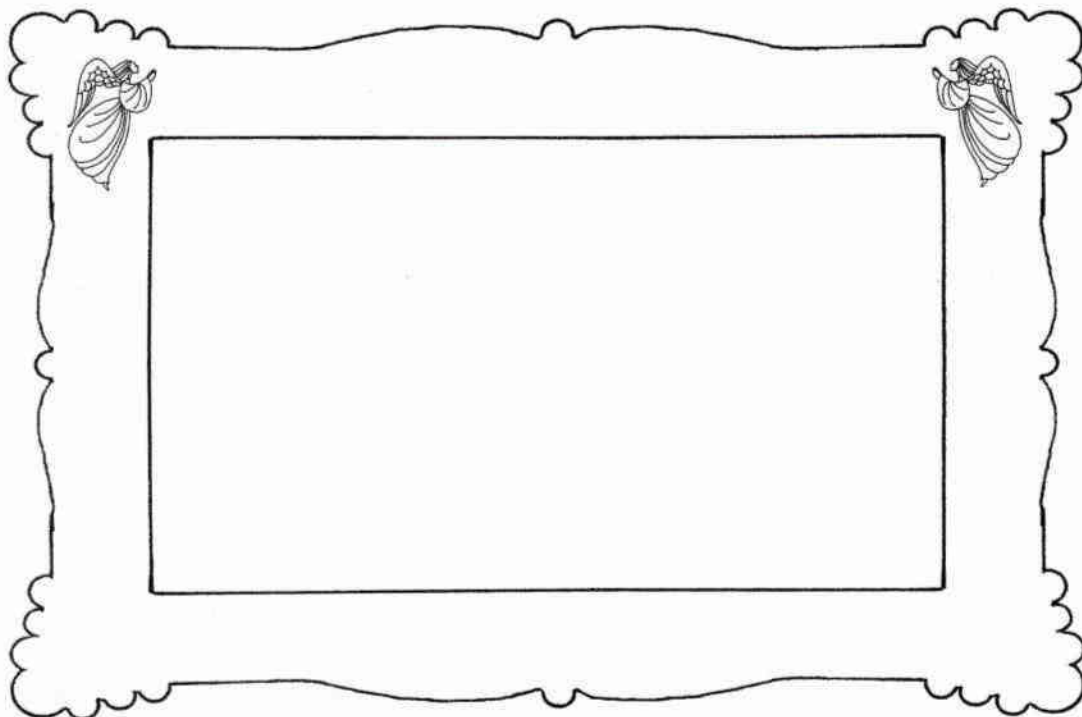
Isaiah the prophet gives us another description that helps us know something about the birth of the Messiah. Read this verse and think about what Isaiah is telling us.

*Therefore the Lord himself will give you this sign,
the (young woman) shall be with child, and bear a son,
and shall name him Immanuel.*

(Isaiah 7:14)

When the Messiah comes into this world as a child, says Isaiah, he will need a very special mother. People wondered who that mother would be. We know that God sent the angel Gabriel to the town of Nazareth to tell this young woman she would become the mother of God. Do you know the name of that woman? The angel told her the baby would be named Jesus. The name Immanuel means "God with us."
