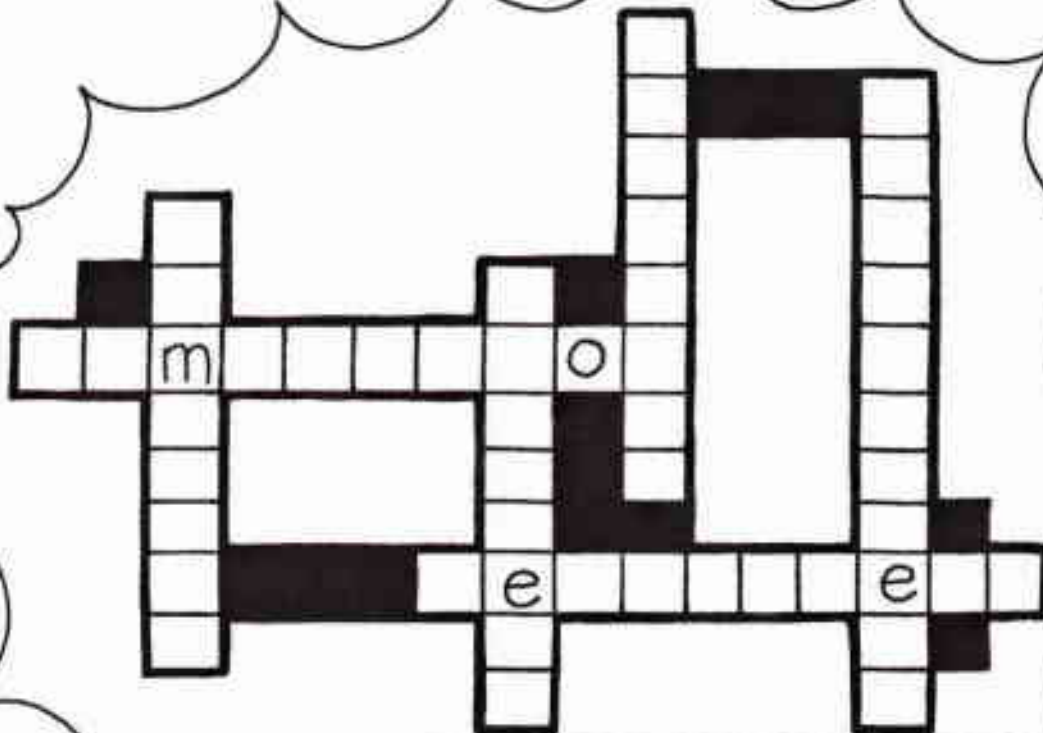

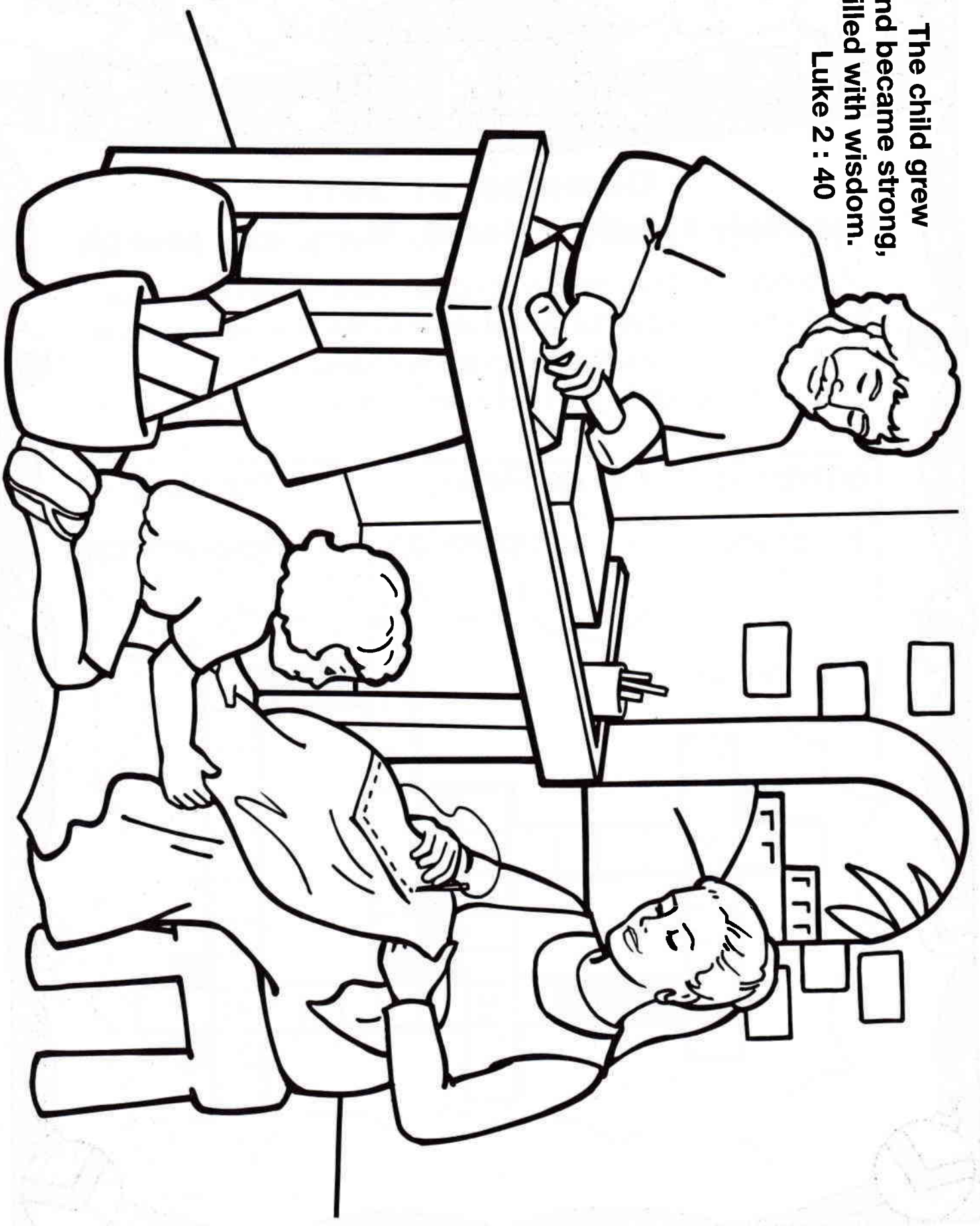

HOLY FAMILIES

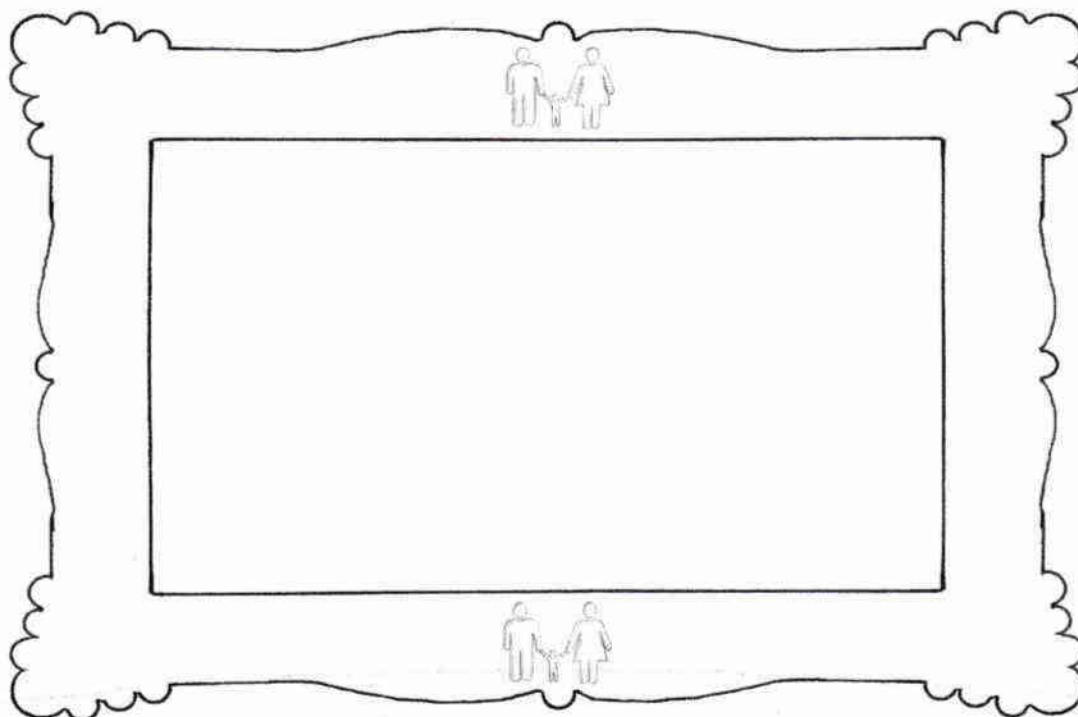
