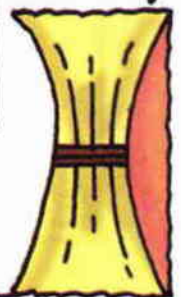
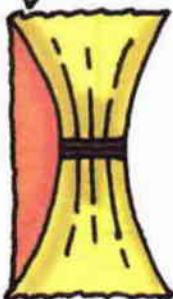

MAKE MUSIC TO THE LORD

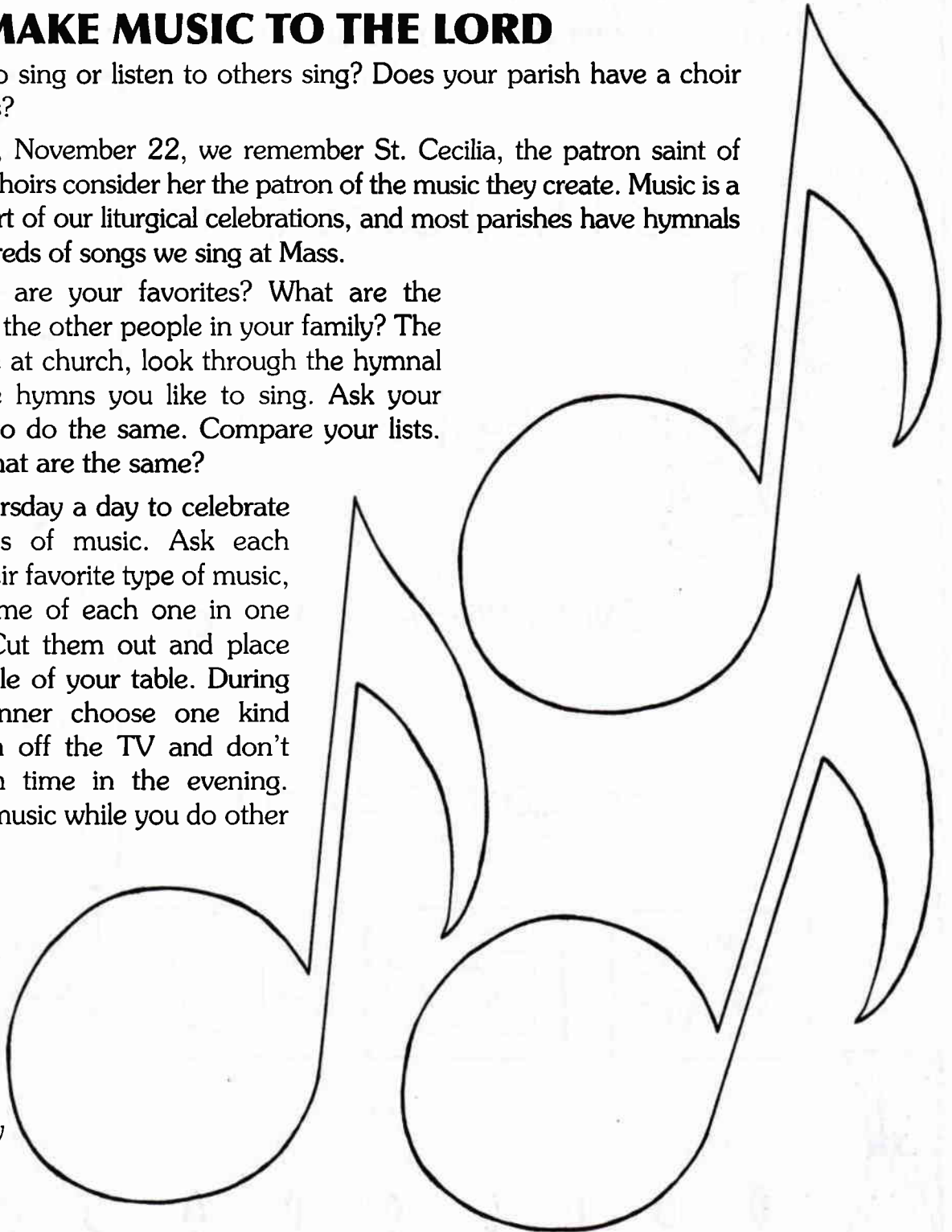
Do you love to sing or listen to others sing? Does your parish have a choir that sings at Mass?

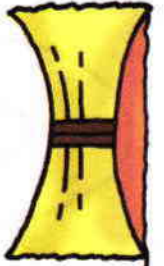
