

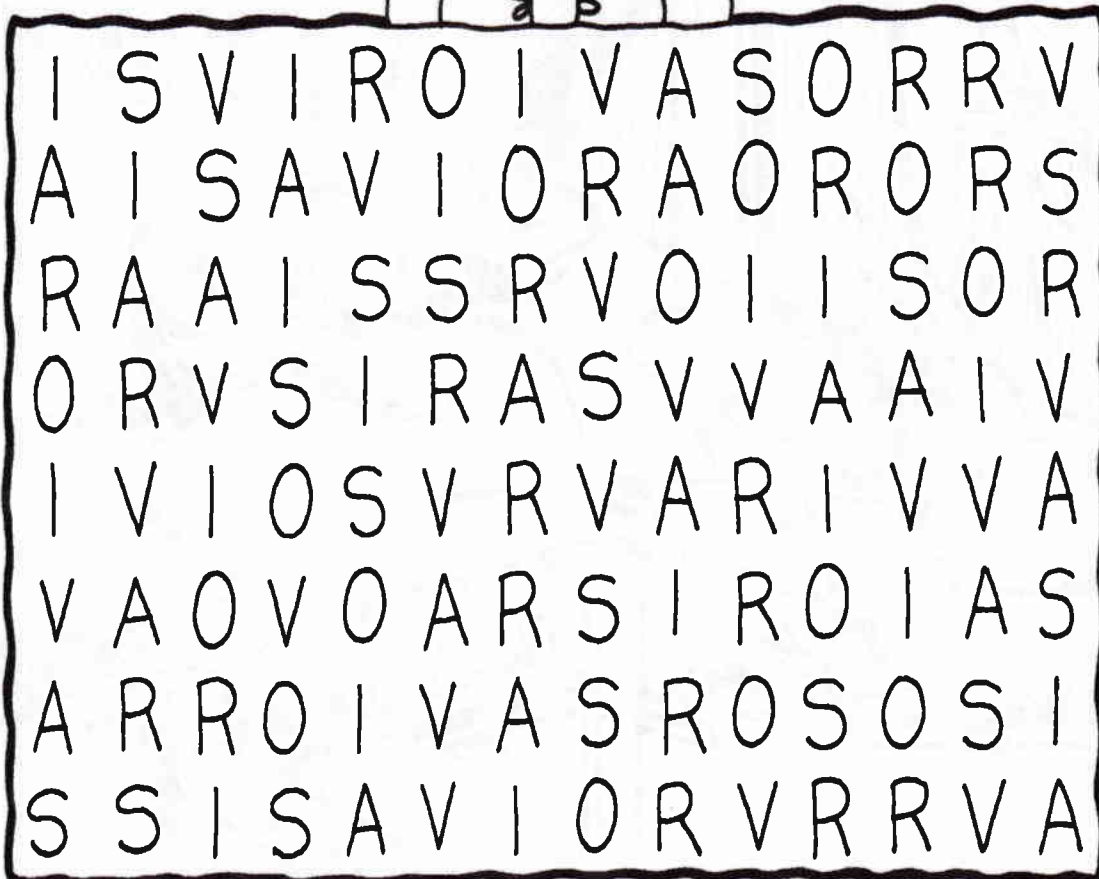
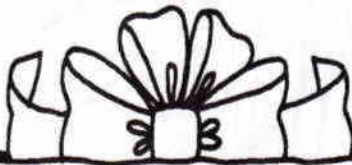
December 25, 2018 Christmas

Today we celebrate the birth of Jesus! All the words of rejoicing from the Third Sunday of Advent are fulfilled today. The whole world is filled with joy!

You may have seen pictures of the town of Bethlehem, where Jesus was born and lived for a while, but the phrase from the beginning of John's Gospel reminds us that today he dwells among us still.
